Site Preparation

Eveon provides customizable delivery options, including [tiltbed](#), [flatbed](#), or a [pickup option](#) for those with the proper equipment. Our network of local truckers ensure delivery in 3-5 business days.

Every successful delivery starts with preparation. We appreciate you choosing Eveon Containers and helping create a safe and efficient delivery experience before your container arrives.

RECOMMENDED FOUNDATIONS

CONCRETE PIERS/PADS

- ▶ Place concrete piers along container rails
- ▶ Keeps the container about 6in off the ground
- ▶ Allows airflow underneath, helping reduce condensation

GRAVEL BED/CRUSHED STONE

- ▶ Spread compact gravel
- ▶ Provides drainage and prevents water pooling
- ▶ Can be combined with railroad ties

CONCRETE FOUNDATION SLAB

- ▶ Pour a full reinforced concrete pad
- ▶ Provides a stable and long-lasting foundation
- ▶ Keeps moisture away and prevents settling
- ▶ Excellent for long-term placement

PRESSURE-TREATED WOOD

- ▶ Cheap and easy to install
- ▶ Lay two or more 4x4s under container rails
- ▶ Raises the container several inches off the ground
- ▶ Must use pressure-treated

HOW TO PREPARE YOUR DELIVERY SITE

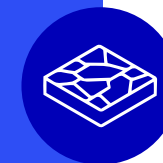

CLEARANCE
Minimum **16ft overhead** and **12ft width**, free of obstacles.



ACCESS TO SITE
Most carriers use 40ft trailer. Allow **100ft for a 20ft container** and **120ft for a 40ft container**.
Straight-line access required



GROUND CONDITIONS
Area must be **flat, level, firm, and dry**.



WEATHER
Postpone if heavy rain or snow is expected.

What to Expect on Delivery Day

At Eveon Containers, we work with experienced, **fully-insured truckers** who have completed thousands of deliveries so your shipment is in trusted hands.

Tiltbed Delivery Process

Most containers are delivered using a tiltbed trailer. During unloading, the trailer lifts at an angle while the container slowly slides into place.

Because of this process, **containers are typically delivered in a straight line from the truck to the final placement location.**

Flatbed Delivery Process

Flatbed delivery involves transporting your container on a flatbed trailer, which differs from the tilt bed method where the container slides off the back of the truck onto the ground. **With flatbed delivery, you are responsible for offloading the container using appropriate equipment like a forklift or crane.**

Be Present During Delivery

Someone should be onsite during delivery to:

- **Confirm placement location**
- **Verify door orientation**
- **Check surrounding clearance**
- **Inspect the container before the driver leaves**

Once placed, used shipping containers can be difficult to reposition without specialized equipment.



Expect Normal Cosmetic Wear

Used containers can show:

- **Surface rust**
- **Dents or patches**
- **Scratches and faded paint**
- **Previous repair markings**

These are normal characteristics of used Corten steel containers and do not affect structural performance or wind & watertight condition.



Inspect Before Signing Off

Before the carrier leaves, inspect the container to confirm:

- **Doors open and close properly**
- **Flooring is solid**
- **No holes are present in walls, roof, or floor**
- **Container matches expected condition**

Signing the inspection form confirms the container meets the agreed-upon delivery condition and wind & watertight standard.



After Placement

Once delivered:

- **Allow the container to settle fully before loading**
- **Re-check door operation after placement**
- **Keep the surrounding area clear for drainage and airflow**
- **Slight shifting may occur if the ground settles unevenly over time**

After delivery, Eveon's Customer Care team is available to assist with any questions or concerns.

Eveon's Inspection Form

Before the driver leaves, **the container should be fully inspected to confirm it meets the agreed-upon wind & watertight standard**, including proper door operation, solid flooring, and overall structural condition.

By signing the form, the **customer acknowledges the container was delivered in acceptable condition** at the time of delivery. **This signed inspection form also serves as the starting point for the Limited Lifetime Warranty coverage.**



► **Part 1 - To be filled out by your driver.**

This section is completed by the delivery driver and **records driver information, recipient information, order number, and container identification** for the delivery record.

► **Part 2 - To be filled out by you and your driver.**

This section is completed by the delivery driver and recipient to confirm the container meets Eveon's wind & watertight quality standards at the time of delivery.

Any qualifying concerns or damages should be documented on the form before the driver leaves the site.

Inspection Points

Review each inspection point carefully before initialing.

- Container is wind & watertight (no holes)
- Seals are intact
- Floor is in good condition (patches are acceptable)
- Doors open & close properly (hinges can be sticky)
- Door hardware functions (locking bars, cam keepers)

- Is the container placed in a location that is dry and level?
- Was the delivery area and driveway clean of obstacles?
- Did you walk around (and in) the entire container with the driver?
- Do you accept this used shipping container as it?

Caring for Your Container

Proper maintenance plays a major role in the long-term performance of a used shipping container. From rust prevention and ventilation to foundation placement and door maintenance, routine care helps protect structural integrity, improve functionality, and extend the lifespan of the container for years to come.

TROUBLESHOOTING STICKY DOORS

- ▶ Use a level to ensure the container is sitting evenly and not pitched at an extreme angle.
- ▶ Lubricate door hinges and locking mechanisms regularly using WD-40 or all-weather lubricant.
- ▶ Place the container on a flat surface or support beams like railroad ties to maintain proper functionality.
- ▶ Keep door areas clean and free of dirt, mud, and rust buildup using soap and warm water.

01 RUST PREVENTION



Surface rust is a normal characteristic of Corten steel, but regular inspections are still important.

Pay close attention to the roof, corners, and door frames, and treat any developing rust with rust-resistant paint or sealants when needed.

02 VENTILATION & MOISTURE CONTROL



Proper airflow helps reduce condensation buildup, especially in humid or rainy environments.

Good ventilation protects both the container and the items stored inside by reducing excess moisture over time.

03 SEALING & FOUNDATION



Inspect door gaskets, seams, and joints regularly to ensure the container remains properly sealed.

Containers should also remain level and elevated on a stable, well-drained foundation to help prevent water pooling and improve airflow underneath.

04 DOOR MAINTENANCE



To keep doors operating smoothly, regularly lubricate hinges and locking mechanisms using products such as WD-40 or all-weather lubricants.

Routine lubrication helps reduce friction, prevent rust, and improve long-term operation.
